Thus, in order to fix this problem, outriggers can be extended from the deck. The outriggers utilize hydraulic pressure in order to slightly lift the truck off of the ground, making it balanced and stable. The crawler crane is unique in that it has big tracks on the base of the crane. These huge tracks are really like backhoes and bulldozers. The tracks allow the crane to move around a construction locations successfully.
